Rendang is made from beef slowly cooked in coconut milk, spices and sometimes kerisik (toasted coconut paste) for several hours until almost all the liquid is gone, allowing the meat to absorb the spicy condiments.

It consists of a set of 5 Kolintang, each with different function, namely Melody, Alto, Tenor, Cello and Bass.
